A.C.C. Approval

Any Resident planning to change the exterior of their property must obtain approval from the A.C.C. Chairman. North Strabane Township will not issue a building permit to any resident of Glencannon unless they have this approval from the association. Approval must be obtained for decks, doors, windows, sidewalks, patios, sheds, painting, etc.

A \$50 fine may be assessed for failure to submit the ACC form with proper approval.

Selling Your Property?

If you are planning to sell your property you will need a "Resale Certificate" signed by a GHA Board Member and the GHA Secretary. The Resale Certificate is issued when all GHA dues and assessments have been received by GHA resulting in a zero balance owed. The Resale Certificate is required for your home Closing.

As a reminder under Act 180, the Association has ten days to provide the Resale Certificate and other items to the seller. Please contact the GHA Secretary as soon as possible so that your Resale Certificate can be prepared.

There is a fee of \$75 for a Resale Certificate.

Attorney Fee Policy

Residents who fail to pay the monthly \$43 assessment for five months or more can expect an official warning letter from Glencannon Homes Association. Failure to respond will result in a letter from the Glencannon Attorney and a \$100 letter drafting fee will be added to the amount owed. Homeowners that force the Attorney file a lien on their property (for lack of payment) will also have those fees added to their account.

Dog Laws

Please remember that Pennsylvania and the township of North Strabane have laws pertaining to DOGS.

Pennsylvania State Law: All dogs must be under control and may not be allowed to run at large. Dogs are personal property and owners are responsible for damages caused by their dogs. This means that when your dog is not on your property, it must be under direct control of you or a handler. The best way to control your dog is with a leash.

North Strabane Township Ordinance:

It shall be unlawful for the owner of any dog or dogs to allow or permit such dog or dogs to run at large in the township of North Strabane.

We ask that all residents please clean up after your pets. Thank you for your cooperation.

Glencannon ACC regulations require that GARBAGE CONTAINERS are to be stored indoors or inconspicuously outdoors (not in front of your residence).

Garbage containers should be placed at the curb no earlier than 5:00 p.m. the night before collection day,

and must be removed the next day.

Mr. Krantz called the meeting to order at 6:30pm Roll Call

Doug Krantz - President, Shawn Beard – Vice President, Terry Creighan, Pat Hogan, Rebecca Lopez, John Ackerman and Dave Wheeler. Gretchen Gregorchik not present and excused. .

Financials

The financial reports were reviewed and discussed. The final draft of the budget for 2023 was reviewed based on the information discussed at the last meeting. Mr. Beard made a motion to approve the budget, Mr. Hogan seconded the motion. Vote: Mr. Creighan – yes, Ms. Lopez – yes, Mr. Ackerman – yes and Mr. Wheeler - yes. The board thanked Jim Byer for his participation in the budget development and past years comparison.

Commons

The landscaping contract for the new year was discussed. A copy of the contract with proposed changes was distributed last week. The details of the bid proposal including the change in snow removal was discussed and the contractors that were contacted so far. The maps that are needed by the landscapers and board were discussed and the potential of making them digital though a local printing store.

ACC - 2 approved

The contract for American Pools was received and is being reviewed. The final review and the bid price will be discussed once it is confirmed. The board also clarified that the prices for the new pool pump were discussed in the fall with American pools but there are no plans to purchase a new one in 2023 because it is not necessary.

Old Business

The pool house renovation project was discussed and a contractor was scheduled for next week to come and look at the area and provide a recommendation and proposal. Two other contractors will be consulted as well. The bids with prices and the scope of work will be gathered for board review.

Mr. Beard made a motion to adjourn, Mr. Ackerman seconded the motion. Vote: Mr. Krantz – yes, Mr. Wheeler- yes, Mr. Hogan -yes and Mr. Creighan – yes and Ms. Lopez – yes.

The pond project was discussed, and the planning meeting occurred with the contractor. The work is still planning to start in the coming weeks.

The lights on Upper Hunting Creek require a new contractor. All electrical contractors are being contacted to bid.

The tree list was discussed in order to start the bidding for the Spring. The list will continue to be updated. The board discussed obtaining bids to seal coat the pool parking lot this year.

Snow removal in the common areas was discussed and Cramer Landscaping will be contacted as needed for the work.

Pond Update!

The work is to commence most likely in the month of February and completed within the month of June as the contract allows for 120 days for completion from the start date.

The utilities have been marked, two permits (including for the footbridge and Chapter 102) is being addressed, and final construction notification has been sent to the Army Corps of Engineers and communication with North Strabane.

For the safety of residents, please do not approach the employees. Questions are to be directed to the Glencannon Secretary. The Secretary may choose to publish them in the Question of the Month section of the Newsletter in lieu of returning every phone call. Calls regarding noise and smells will not be returned as it is to be expected. Construction will only take place during the hours North Strabane permits. Three Board members have been identified to check-in with Mullen employees.

Please plan accordingly for reduced speed and periods when the pond section of Hunting Creek Road may be either closed or reduced to one lane. Road closures will not be announced in advance.

No Trespassing signs and game cameras will be posted in various areas around the pond,

baseball field, and field below the dam. Regardless of whether signs are present, it is expected that no one walk around the pond or the two fields when construction workers are present. When workers are not present, residents may walk the path and the fields provided they can remain 50 feet away from any equipment, tools, and vehicles.

Under no circumstances is anyone permitted to walk in the bed of the pond regardless of whether it looks dry.

The Board and Contractors appreciate your patience and understanding during this long-awaited project.

Property Condition:

Failure to do these improvements can result in a \$50 fine.
