A.C.C. Approval

Any Resident planning to change the exterior of their property must obtain approval from the A.C.C. Chairman. North Strabane Township will not issue a building permit to any resident of Glencannon unless they have this approval from the association. Approval must be obtained for decks, doors, windows, sidewalks, patios, sheds, painting, etc.

A \$50 fine may be assessed for failure to submit the ACC form with proper approval.

Selling Your Property?

If you are planning to sell your property you will need a "Resale Certificate" signed by a GHA Board Member and the GHA Secretary. The Resale Certificate is issued when all GHA dues and assessments have been received by GHA resulting in a zero balance owed. The Resale Certificate is required for your home Closing.

As a reminder under Act 180, the Association has ten days to provide the Resale Certificate and other items to the seller. Please contact the GHA Secretary as soon as possible so that your Resale Certificate can be prepared.

There is a fee of \$75 for a Resale Certificate.

Attorney Fee Policy

Residents who fail to pay the monthly \$43 assessment for five months or more can expect an official warning letter from Glencannon Homes Association. Failure to respond will result in a letter from the Glencannon Attorney and a \$100 letter drafting fee will be added to the amount owed. Homeowners that force the Attorney file a lien on their property (for lack of payment) will also have those fees added to their account.


Although New Year's Day, Independence Day, and Thanksgiving are listed holidays, they take place after our normal collection day.

Dog Laws

Please remember that Pennsylvania and the township of North Strabane have laws pertaining to DOGS.

Pennsylvania State Law: All dogs must be under control and may not be allowed to run at large. Dogs are personal property and owners are responsible for damages caused by their dogs. This means that when your dog is not on your property, it must be under direct control of you or a handler. The best way to control your dog is with a leash.

North Strabane Township Ordinance:

It shall be unlawful for the owner of any dog or dogs to allow or permit such dog or dogs to run at large in the township of North Strabane.

We ask that all residents please clean up after your pets. Thank you for your cooperation.

Glencannon ACC regulations require that GARBAGE CONTAINERS are to be stored indoors or inconspicuously outdoors (not in front of your residence).

Garbage containers should be placed at the curb no earlier than 5:00 p.m. the night before collection day, and must be removed the next day.

Mr. Krantz called the meeting to order at 6:30pm

Roll Call

Doug Krantz - President, Shawn Beard - Vice President, Gretchen Gregorchik, Terry Creighan, Pat Hogan, Rebecca Lopez and Dave Wheeler. John Ackerman- not present and excused.

Vince Eannace at Stelmack Debransky and Eannace was present. He distributed and explained the details of the 2021 Audit. Mr. Eannace stated that there were no issues or concerns from the audit and no further recommendations.

Financials

The board discussed the details of the financial reports that were distributed. Further discussion occurred relating to the AR list and overdue accounts.

Commons

The board discussed the landscaping contract that is due to renew soon. The board also discussed the issues with some of the problem areas in the Spring and Summer. Since then, there has been a lot of progress and consistency. There needs to be additional changes and clarification to the contract for renewal. Cramer Landscaping will provide a bid soon for review. Additional changes to snow removal were discussed including the potential of separating it out of the contract and paying as needed.

Rec

The pool is closed, and general maintenance and winterizing is underway with both the building and the slide. The final invoice with American Pools was discussed and was approved for payment. Additional changes to the upcoming contract including pool chemicals will be discussed with American Pools in the future.

ACC – 4 requests submitted, 2 were approved and 2 were denied pending additional information.

New Business

The board discussed the upcoming renewal for the liability insurance. The broker is looking for proposals for the November renewal policy and they will be distributed once obtained. The board discussed also looking independently for bids.

The monthly meeting location continues to be a struggle. The library is no longer an option and all venues that were contacted except for Kings have been unavailable. The board agreed to have the 22-23 meetings at Kings from November 2022 to March of 2023. Meeting adjourned at 7pm.

Commons

The pond project was discussed, the contract for Mullen Excavating was reviewed and signed. The current update from the Harshman CE Group is that one of the permits expired and is getting renewed. Mullen must provide one more insurance detail as well. The work is to start in November of 2022.

Old Business

The open board positions were reviewed. There was one resident present, he did not wish to be on the board.

New Business

The board discussed a few trees that need addressed through either trimming or removal. The tree list needs to be revised and the board discussed going around and providing any additional trees that need addressed.

Questions of the Month

Can I put a mailbox up in my yard?

No. Mailboxes are not permitted according to the ACC Guidelines on most streets.

What happens if I don't pay my dues?

If the balance on the dues is high and requires a lien, Glencannon Homes Association has the right to Foreclose on the property.

Is the board able to address issues with tics, mosquitos or other insects in the community or on common properties?

No. This cannot be addressed. However, please contact the office if there are any bee hives on playground equipment or in the pool area. This can be addressed by the board or the landscapers.



REMINDER:

The only sign that is permitted on Glencannon properties is a real estate (for sale) sign.

Contractor signs, advertising and political signs are not permitted (at any time).

Thank you for your cooperation.

Property Condition:

The GHA board and residents

continue to report properties that are in need of repair or improvement.

Letters are sent to these residents regularly identifying what needs done, and completed within 30 days.

Failure to do these improvements can result in a \$50 fine.

Notice:

Vehicles without current inspection stickers are <u>not</u> permitted to be parked in Glencannon commons parking pads. In addition, vehicles parked in commons parking for long periods of time will be researched for resident ownership.

These vehicles will be towed at the owners expense.

Dirt Bikes and Quads are NOT permitted to be driven on Glencannon common grounds (the pond, the ballfield, the pool complex or near the playgrounds).

Several warnings have been issued by the police, GHA has authorized citations for future violations.
