A.C.C. Approval

Any Resident planning to change the exterior of their property must obtain approval from the A.C.C. Chairman. North Strabane Township will not issue a building permit to any resident of Glencannon unless they have this approval from the association. Approval must be obtained for decks, doors, windows, sidewalks, patios, sheds, painting, etc.

A \$50 fine may be assessed for failure to submit the ACC form with proper approval.

Selling Your Property?

If you are planning to sell your property you will need a "Resale Certificate" signed by a GHA Board Member and the GHA Secretary. The Resale Certificate is issued when all GHA dues and assessments have been received by GHA resulting in a zero balance owed. The Resale Certificate is required for your home Closing.

As a reminder under Act 180, the Association has ten days to provide the Resale Certificate and other items to the seller. Please contact the GHA Secretary as soon as possible so that your Resale Certificate can be prepared.

There is a fee of \$75 for a Resale Certificate.

Attorney Fee Policy

Residents who fail to pay the monthly \$43 assessment for five months or more can expect an official warning letter from Glencannon Homes Association. Failure to respond will result in a letter from the Glencannon Attorney and a \$100 letter drafting fee will be added to the amount owed. Homeowners that force the Attorney file a lien on their property (for lack of payment) will also have those fees added to their account.


Although New Year's Day, Independence Day, and Thanksgiving are listed holidays, they take place after our normal collection day.

Dog Laws

Please remember that Pennsylvania and the township of North Strabane have laws pertaining to DOGS.

Pennsylvania State Law: All dogs must be under control and may not be allowed to run at large. Dogs are personal property and owners are responsible for damages caused by their dogs. This means that when your dog is not on your property, it must be under direct control of you or a handler. The best way to control your dog is with a leash.

North Strabane Township Ordinance:

It shall be unlawful for the owner of any dog or dogs to allow or permit such dog or dogs to run at large in the township of North Strabane.

We ask that all residents please clean up after your pets. Thank you for your cooperation.

Glencannon ACC regulations require that GARBAGE CONTAINERS are to be stored indoors or inconspicuously outdoors (not in front of your residence).

Garbage containers should be placed at the curb no earlier than 5:00 p.m. the night before collection day, and must be removed

the next day.

Glencannon Homes Association Executive Meeting - Minutes September 13, 2022

Mr. Krantz called the meeting to order at 6:30pm

Roll Call

Doug Krantz - President, Terry Creighan, Pat Hogan, Rebecca Lopez and Dave Wheeler. John Ackerman, Shawn Beard and Gretchen Gregorchik – not present and excused.

Financials

The board discussed the details of the financial reports that were distributed last week.

Commons

The board discussed the fencing project. Seward Fencing is doing the work and will provide a date when they can start within their schedule. This will begin possibly this fall or in the Spring.

The bench on Old Meadow was discussed and the fact that it is damaged. The company was contacted, and a replacement piece will be ordered to repair it.

The lights at the Hunting Creek Island were discussed and there is one bid obtained to repair them. Another board member stated he will try to get additional bids.

The pond project was discussed, and the contractor was chosen — Mullen Excavating. The Engineers at Harshman CE Group are working with them to obtain all the necessary paperwork and create the contract.

The height of the equipment at Playground A was discussed as well as the bench that has been on back order. Jeffrey's was contacted about both, no update yet.

Rec

The pool is closed, and general maintenance and winterizing is underway. The final invoice with American Pools was discussed as well as changes necessary to the contract next year regarding pool cleaning and chemicals

ACC - 1 request submitted and was approved.

New Business

The board discussed the upcoming renewal for the liability policy and additional bids are being obtained by the broker.

The meeting location was discussed and continues to be an issue during the winter months. The library is no longer an option due to their closing time at 7pm. Additional places were discussed and will be contacted. The October meeting will be at the pool pavilion.

The cars in common spaces on Hickory Circle and Old Meadow that are out of inspection were discussed. These cars have also been reported as abandoned since they haven't moved in many months. Further information will be obtained about the owners and notifying them.

The 2021 Audit is completed and will be discussed with Stelmack, Dobransky and Eannace at the Executive meeting in October.

Old Business

A property in the community was discussed and the foreclosure process that occurred due to unpaid dues. The property owner is paying off the balance in the coming days.

The pond project was discussed, the board voted and accepted the bid from Mullen Excavating. The Engineers are working with Mullen Excavating to gather the needed paperwork and create the contract.

Rec

The board discussed general maintenance for the pool. In addition, toward the end of the summer the cleaning and vacuuming of the pool was not done consistently. Several members of the board will discuss this with American Pools and how this impacts the use of chemicals.

What do I do if I am behind on my dues?

Please contact the office to discuss a payment arrangement. Several arrangements can avoid finance charges. Details of the payment arrangement policy can be found on the website at www.glencannonhomes.org

What is happening with cars in the community with expired registration and inspection?

If you have a car in a commons parking spot on Hickory Circle, Old Meadow, Cricketwood or Pheasant Cove that hasn't moved and has expired tags, move it immediately. These cars will receive notification in the near future and will be towed.

What is the update on the Pond Project?

The contractor chosen is working with the engineers to develop the contract and submit all necessary paperwork. The work will begin once this is completed.



REMINDER:

The only sign that is permitted on Glencannon properties is a real estate (for sale) sign.

Contractor signs, advertising and political signs are not permitted (at any time).

Thank you for your cooperation.

Property Condition:

The GHA board and residents

continue to report properties that are in need of repair or improvement.

Letters are sent to these residents regularly identifying what needs done, and completed within 30 days.

Failure to do these improvements can result in a \$50 fine.

Notice:

Vehicles without current inspection stickers are <u>not</u> permitted to be parked in Glencannon commons parking pads. In addition, vehicles parked in commons parking for long periods of time will be researched for resident ownership.

These vehicles will be towed at the owners expense.

Dirt Bikes and Quads are NOT permitted to be driven on Glencannon common grounds (the pond, the ballfield, the pool complex or near the playgrounds).

Several warnings have been issued by the police, GHA has authorized citations for future violations.
